Purification via worship ensures the landscape of one's life is freed of drama, toxic feeds and undetected causations to behaviour that may fluctuate the mental landscape.

Purification is understood across faiths, and occurs in various ways.

Purification is possible through the worship of the following in the Buddhist faith (see table).

The states of the deities reflected in representations, speak of transactional responses and cognizant energy appreciations that are 'active' – Subtle-body work and purification is an incredible support to the Wellbeing of the worshipper. Purification is also a part of "passage determination", through the pledge of the Buddhist path into one's life.
